Goal Setting Conferences with teachers, parents and children will be held on Wednesday 6th March. The first appointment will be at 3.15pm and the last appointment will be at 7pm with a break for dinner between 5pm and 5.30pm.

To book meetings, go to www.schoolinterviews.co.nz/code in your computer browser, and enter the event **code mc87u**. Then follow these three simple steps:



First enter your name, your child's name, and your email address. If you need to book for more than one child, change the "Book for x students" setting, and enter the other student's name.



On the next page, pick the teachers you want to meet.



Then you'll see a timetable showing when your chosen teachers are available. Simply click on the times that suit you.

When you have finished, your meeting timetable will be emailed to you. You can return to the site and enter the event code mc87u again to change or cancel your meetings.
